

## Sports Premium Grant Report for the Financial Year 2017-18

We have used the sports funding for 3 years for specialist PE coaching provision from Milton Keynes Sports Partnership. We sought advice from them to plan our next steps. It was agreed that this year we would work together on developing a skills based scheme of work, audit current equipment and order additional resources. Additionally we would use their expertise together with HIT5 to develop the health and wellbeing provision. We would continue funding the continued use of the village hall for two PE session per week together with an additional TA due to the location of the hall so as to guarantee a quality PE environment throughout the year.
