

Pupil Premium

The Pupil Premium is ring-fenced funding from the Government and is allocated to schools to use appropriately to provide additional support for children of low income families who are currently eligible and take up the free school meal service. This funding is also allocated to schools to support children who have been looked after continuously for more than six months. It is important, therefore, that families who are eligible complete and submit the appropriate documentation in order that the funding is received each year. Pupil Premium is used for the purpose of raising attainment.

Pupil premium gives us flexibility to target needs of individuals or groups. The ability to respond to short and medium term needs is key to raising achievement.

Pupil Premium Spending 2016-17 and 2017-18

As we are a small village school, the details of Pupil Premium spend below have been documented without specifics as this could identify the individual pupils and breach confidentiality.

The funding and impact was spent in the following ways:

- TA hours for 1:1/small group support delivering specific interventions for the pupil's needs. There was a noticeable increase in the pupil's confidence from the support given. The same TA supported the pupils in class with identified areas of need.
- Breakfast club was paid for.
