



Castlethorpe First School Parent Protocol for School Reopening from June 1st 2020

At Castlethorpe School our priority is to keep all our pupils, their families and our staff safe.

There are steps we can all take to help each other stay safe and healthy.

During this time school will feel very different for all of us. This guide will help us to understand the role we each play in supporting and protecting everyone in our Castlethorpe 'family'.

Do not bring your child to school if they or a family member have coronavirus symptoms and access a test as soon as possible.

If symptoms develop during the day your child will need to go home and access a test.

Children will be asked to wash their hands or use hand sanitiser more frequently than usual: as they enter the building, before and after they eat, and after coughing or sneezing.

Please send your child in clean (non-uniform) clothes each day.

Depending on the weather send them with a coat or sun hat.

They need a named water bottle and a piece of fruit for morning snack.

On sunny days they should come to school already wearing sun cream.

We can only allow one parent to come onto the school site to bring and collect your child.

Please do not enter the school building.

Please use the School Lane gate entry.

Please do not arrive early. Drop your child off at the correct timeslot

Leave promptly and follow social distancing guidelines. Do not gather and chat in groups with other parents as you arrive and leave the site.

If you need to contact school please phone or e mail.

Attendance registers are kept every day. If we are expecting your child and they are not coming in please phone school to let us know why.

Classroom doors and windows will be kept open, if safe to do so for air flow.

Only 1 or 2 children will use the bathroom at one time.

There will be separate playground areas for each 'bubble'.

Children will be taught to follow the rules on hand cleaning, not touching their faces, and 'catch it, bin it, kill it'.

Staff will be available to remind children.

The use of shared resources will be limited.

Frequently touched surfaces and toys will be cleaned throughout the day.

Children will be expected to follow these rules.

Children may bring a scooter and helmet for their own use only but no other toys or other items from home.

Class teachers will post on face book the day for book changes do not bring book bags.
