

Pupil Premium

Pupil Premium is funding which is awarded to schools for each pupil registered for a Free School Meal. Currently, this funding is £900 per pupil. The money is paid directly to schools and is used to improve the educational outcomes for children entitled to a free school meal.

Entitlement to free school meals is kept as confidential as possible. The free school meal will remain in place for as long as your child continues to attend school in Milton Keynes and you continue to be entitled to one of the qualifying benefits listed below.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
